## Status of licensing systems and focal points

### Note by the Secretariat

1. The present note has been revised to include details of disaggregated information received from additional parties as at 9 November 2011 and to correct information provided on Timor-Leste in the original version of the document. The additional information received between 15 October 2011 and 9 November 2011 was submitted by the following parties to the Montreal Amendment: Central African Republic, Equatorial Guinea, Gabon, Haiti, Mauritius, Peru, Qatar, Ukraine and United Arab Emirates. Nicaragua, a non-party to the Montreal Amendment, also provided information on disaggregated data over the same period.

### **I. Licensing systems (Article 4B, paragraph 4, of the Montreal Protocol)**

2. Licensing systems play a key role in assisting parties to comply with their obligations under the Montreal Protocol on Substances that Deplete the Ozone Layer. They are used to monitor the import and export of ozone-depleting substances, prevent illegal trade and enable parties to collect data on consumption of ozone-depleting substances. The requirement for parties to the Protocol to establish and implement systems for licensing the import and export of ozone-depleting substances was introduced to the Montreal Protocol in 1997 by the Montreal Amendment to the Protocol (Article 4B), which entered into force on 10 November 1999. Details on the status of implementation of licensing systems by parties follow below.

#### **A. Article 4B of the Montreal Protocol**

3. Article 4B of the Montreal Protocol requires each party to the Protocol to establish a system for licensing the import and export of new, used, recycled and reclaimed controlled substances listed in Annexes A, B, C and E to the Protocol by 1 January 2000 or three months after the date of entry into force of Article 4B for the party. Pursuant to paragraph 4 of Article 4B, the Secretariat is required to prepare and circulate periodically to all parties a list of parties that have reported to the Secretariat on their licensing systems. The Secretariat is also required to forward that list to the Implementation Committee for its consideration and appropriate recommendations to the parties.

## **B. Recommendation 46/12 of the Implementation Committee**

4. At its forty-sixth meeting, in Montreal, Canada, in August 2011, the Implementation Committee reviewed the status of licensing systems established by parties to the Protocol to date. In the ensuing discussion, views were expressed on how the reporting of information on licensing systems by parties could be improved. One such view was that in its periodic reports on licensing systems the Secretariat should provide information disaggregated by annex and by country to facilitate consideration of whether licensing systems were in place for all substances. The report prepared by the Secretariat for consideration by the Committee at that meeting contained only a table that indicated for each party whether it had reported having a licensing system in place but did not show which substances were within the purview of the system.

5. The Committee adopted recommendation 46/12, by which it requested the Secretariat to prepare for its consideration at its forty-seventh meeting information on the extent to which each party's licensing system covered the substances in the annexes and groups of the Protocol and to provide ideas on how such disaggregation of information might be achieved in the future.

6. In response to the Committee's request, the Secretariat has prepared the present note, annex I to which provides a summary of the Protocol annexes and groups of substances falling within the purview of each party's licensing system. The text in orange in that annex indicates information submitted between 15 October 2011 and 9 November 2011.

## **C. Status of information reported on licensing systems**

7. Annex I to the present note lists all parties and non-parties to the Montreal Amendment that by 15 October 2011 had reported having established licensing systems to the Secretariat. The information provided in the annex is disaggregated to show the annexes and groups of substances of the Protocol that fall within the purview of each party's licensing system. Information on whether the licensing system controls both imports and exports of ozone-depleting substances is also provided.

8. There are 185 parties to the Montreal Amendment to the Montreal Protocol. Of those, 182 have confirmed the establishment and implementation of such systems. Three of the 185 parties – Ethiopia, San Marino and Timor-Leste – have reported that they do not have licensing systems. Ethiopia and Timor-Leste have, however, reported that they are in the process of completing the establishment of their licensing systems. No information has been received from San Marino in this regard.

9. In terms of providing disaggregated data, 173 parties have provided disaggregated information on the groups of controlled substances in Annexes A, B, C and E to the Protocol covered by their licensing systems. They have confirmed that their licensing systems control both imports and exports of all ozone-depleting substances. In the case of Chad, Comoros, Gambia, Libya and Solomon Islands, however, they have indicated that their licensing systems control only imports. Those parties report that they do not produce or export ozone-depleting substances and none has reported to the Secretariat any production or exports of ozone-depleting substances, except for Solomon Islands, which reported on export of ozone-depleting substances only once, in 1999. The remaining nine parties to the Montreal Amendment have provided no disaggregated information on which controlled substances are covered under their licensing systems. They have accordingly been requested to provide such information to the Secretariat. Three parties – Honduras, Sudan and Togo – report that their licensing systems control imports and exports of the substances in Annexes A, B, and E to the Protocol but not those in Annex C (hydrochlorofluorocarbons (HCFCs)). They have indicated, however, that efforts are under way to license HCFCs once their HCFC phase-out management plans have been completed.

10. Ten non-parties to the Montreal Amendment have no legal obligation to establish and implement licensing systems but have nevertheless done so. Eight of them (Côte d'Ivoire, Libya, Morocco, Myanmar, Nepal, Nicaragua, Saudi Arabia and Zimbabwe) have reported disaggregated information on the substances covered by their systems.

11. In summary:

- (a) A total of 185 parties have ratified the Montreal Amendment;
- (b) A total of 182 parties have established licensing systems, while three (Ethiopia, San Marino and Timor-Leste) have not yet done so;
- (c) A total of 173 parties have provided disaggregated information on their licensing systems, while nine have not yet done so;

(d) Ten non-parties to the Montreal Amendment have reported on the establishment of licensing systems, eight of which have provided disaggregated information on their licensing systems;

(e) In total, 11 countries (nine parties and two non-parties to the Montreal Amendment) have not yet provided disaggregated information on their licensing systems;

(f) Botswana is the only country that is both a non-party to the Montreal Amendment and has not yet established a licensing system;

(g) Overall, 192 parties to the Montreal Protocol report that they have established and are implementing licensing systems. This number includes 10 parties to the Montreal Protocol that have not yet ratified the Montreal Amendment to the Protocol and are under no legal obligation to implement such systems. This figure of 192 parties excludes Botswana, Ethiopia, San Marino and Timor-Leste;

(h) The parties that have established licensing systems but have provided no disaggregated information on annexes and groups of substances controlled under their licensing systems have been requested to report such information as soon as possible. The Secretariat will provide an update with regard to those parties by the time of the Implementation Committee's forty-seventh meeting;

(i) The successful phase-out of all ozone-depleting substances in Annexes A and B to the Protocol by all parties is largely attributed to the establishment and implementation of licensing systems. The implementation of those systems is also associated with the unprecedented data reporting on production and consumption of ozone-depleting substances under Article 7 of the Protocol by all parties in 2010 for the data applicable to the year 2009. Equally noteworthy is the deterrent effect of the licensing systems, as evidenced by a reduction in cases of reported illegal trade in ozone-depleting substances in recent years. In addition, where illegal trade has taken place, licensing systems have been used to take action against offenders.

## **II. Focal points**

12. To facilitate the efficient notification, reporting and cross-checking of information on licensing systems, by decision IX/8 each party was invited to inform the Secretariat of the name and contact details of a focal point to whom information and requests should be directed. Annex II to the present note contains a list of names and contact details of such focal points, updated as at 15 October 2011. Parties are encouraged to check the details concerning their focal points and to send to the Secretariat any necessary corrections and updates. The list has not been formally edited.
